Dr Korotkova is the Deputy Director in International Collaboration of Federal Research Institute for Health Organization and Informatics of Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation. She studied Medicine and Informatics in Russian National Research Medical University and in 1992, earned a PhD in field of Health Informatics at the Public Health Research Institute.

Dr Korotkova was an adviser of a Russian member of Standing Committee of the Regional Committee WHO and Executive Board WHO and the Director of the Russian-USA Quality Improvement Project in 30 subjects of the Russian Federation. Dr Korotkova is a head of the WHO Collaboration Centre on health systems and public health, Co-Chair of the European Health Information Initiative (EURO-WHO), and the Russian representative in Expert group on Primary Care in the Partnership in the field of public health and social well-being.
