Fiji is a low HIV prevalence country with an estimated 730 people living with HIV in 2016. However, there is a notably high prevalence of sexually transmitted infections such as gonorrhoea with an incidence rate of 135.13 per 100,000 people in 2014. Surveys have also demonstrated that there is relatively little knowledge about HIV, accompanied by low rates of condom use and high risk sexual practices among youth.

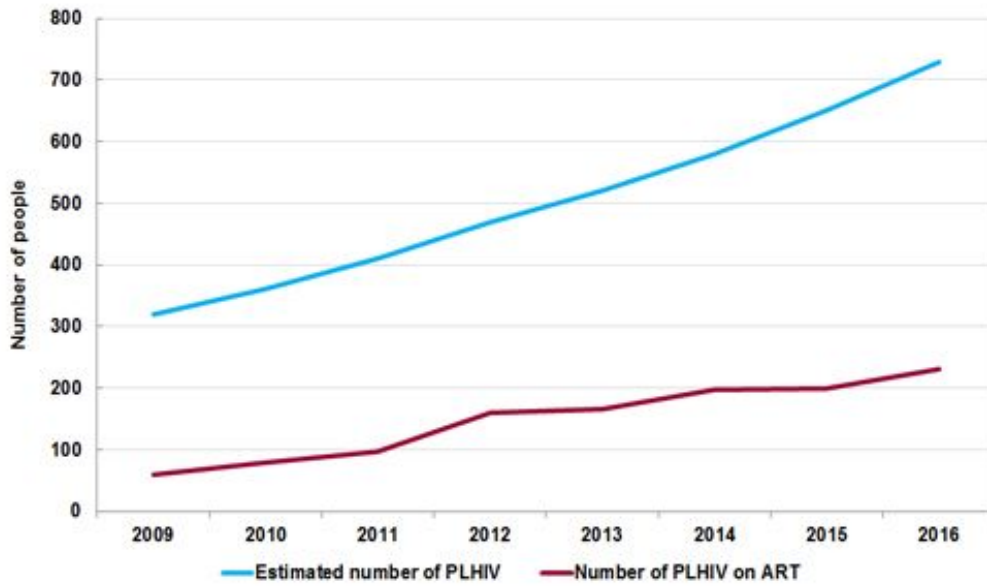
